Women's safety audits pilots

Thank you for your answer to my question 2024/0564, in which you said: "In the spring, MOPAC and TfL [Transport for London] will be launching women's safety audits pilots in a range of locations across London, where local women will audit public spaces to inform how they can be made safer and welcoming for women." Could you update me on the findings from these women's safety audits pilots?

Date: Wednesday 22 January 2025

MOPAC and TfL co-commissioned 'We Made That' to develop women's safety audit pilots in five local authority locations across London (Lambeth, Westminster, Waltham Forest, Brent and Hillingdon) between May and August 2024.

The pilot involved working with almost 50 community researchers: local people who were trained up to lead peer-to-peer research, to design innovative approaches to conducting women's safety audits.

The community researchers led 1 or 2 audits each with around 100 friends, family and colleagues to further capture women's experiences of safety, ensuring that the methods used to conduct the audits are inclusive and accessible.

Following the conclusion of the pilot, a how-to guide and other resources will be made publicly available in the spring to empower organisations and community groups to conduct their own Women's Safety Audits and create safer spaces in their local areas. The learning from the audits will also be used withing TfL's design guidance.
